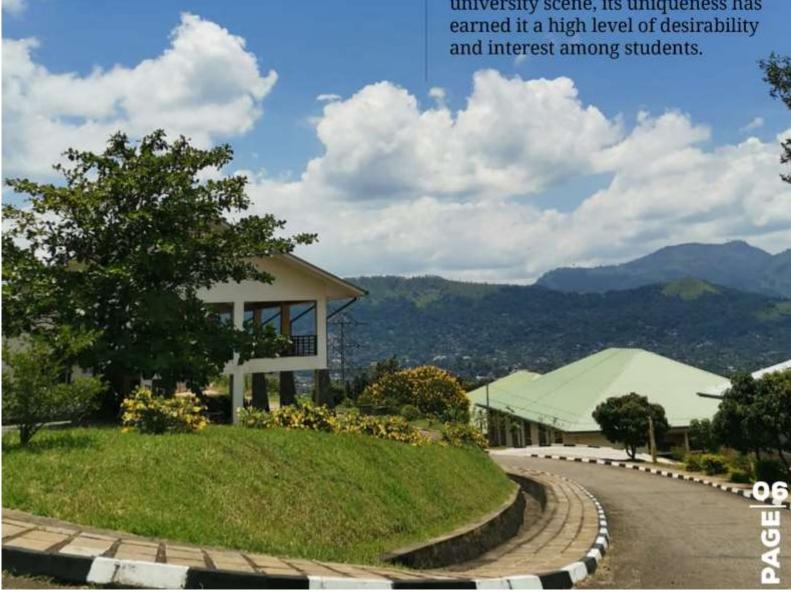

UVA WELLASSA UNIVERSITY OF SRI LANKA (LITTLE HOGWARTS)

The Uva Wellassa University of is the 14th national university which has been established in Sri Lanka by the government gazette with effect from June 1, 2005 in the Badulla district of Uva Province, 3km away from Badulla town towards Passara. Because of the beauty, approachable paths, and climatic variations of the location, undergraduates used to call the university "Little Hogwarts".

Other than the universities in Sri Lanka, UWU has approached a unique recognition by being the one and only Entrepreneurial University with four faculties: Animal Science & Export Agriculture, Faculty of Applied sciences, Faculty of Managemevnt and Faculty of Technological studies under the supervision of current vice chancellor Professor Jayantha Lal Rathnasekara. The total land area covered by the university is 59 acres, 24 acres from an abandoned industrial site of the Ministry of Industries and 35 acres from Glen Alpine Estate of Balangoda Plantations PLC. Despite the fact that the UWU is new to the Sri Lankan university scene, its uniqueness has earned it a high level of desirability and interest among students.

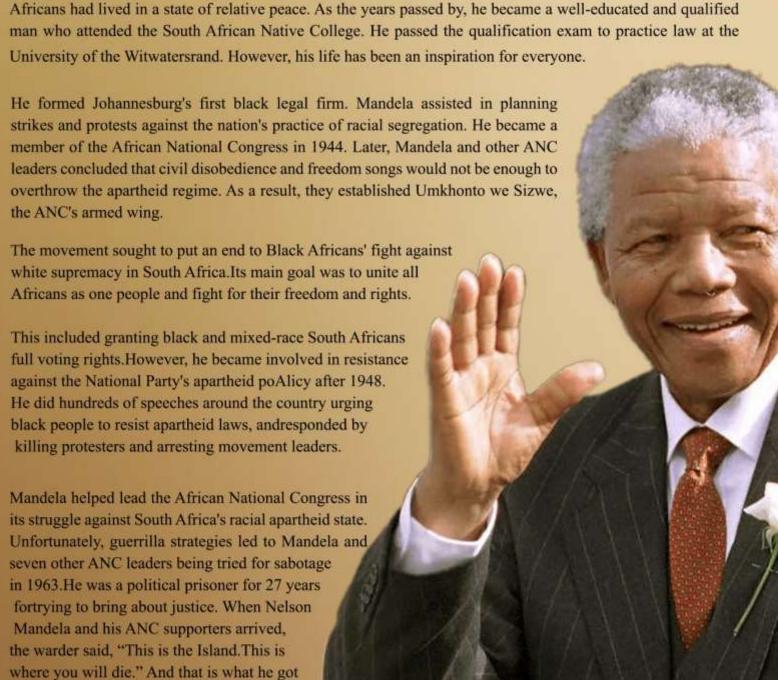

Nelson Mandela inspirational story

Nelson Mandela died as one of the most renowned statesmen in the world despite being born in a nation that treated him as a second-class citizen. From his childhood, till his adult years, he experienced a new struggle every day.

Nelson Rolihlahla Mandela, real name Rolihlahla Mandela, was born on July 18, 1918, in the Umtata village of South Africa. His father, who is the chief of the Madiba clan, died when Nelson was still young. Mandela started getting interested in African history during this time. He discovered that until the arrival of the white people, Africans had lived in a state of relative peace. As the years passed by, he became a well-educated and qualified man who attended the South African Native College. He passed the qualification exam to practice law at the University of the Witwatersrand, However, his life has been an inspiration for everyone.

During this time, he was diagnosed with tuberculosis and as a Black political prisoner, he received the worst care possible from the guards. Mandela was able to complete a correspondence course at the University of London and obtain a Bachelor of Law degree, while he was imprisoned. During this time, he wrote, "Prison life is about routine- each day like the one before, each week like the one before it, so that the months and years blend into each other,". Still, his determination and intellect were remained unwavering.

Nelson Mandela compared his time spent in jail to a 27-year vacation. This was another instance of the dark humor that South Africa's first black president was famous for, which was distinctive, and frequently self-deprecating. Mandela and President de Klerk shared the Nobel Peace Prize in 1993 in recognition of their efforts to end apartheid in South Africa. Nelson Mandela was an inspiration to millions and had a positive influence on young people through his speeches. He often used the phrase "Do not judge me by my successes, judge me by how many times I fell down and got back up again" when quoting others.

Nelson Mandela is an inspiration for the whole world because he will be remembered for his leadership and struggle for justice, equality, freedom, and truth. He motivated many of us with his life, struggles, thoughts, and acts because, unlike many of his countrymen who exploit comparable ideas for self-promotion. He not only talked but also walked it. 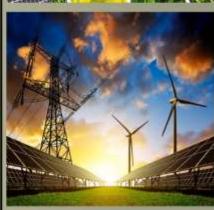

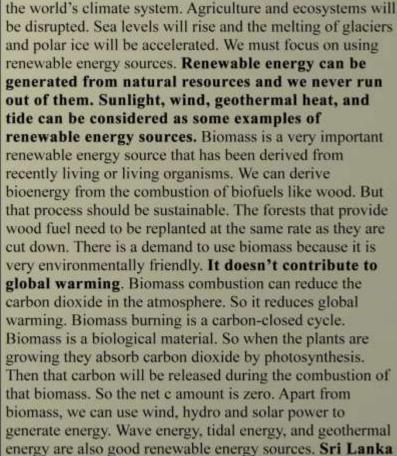


ENERGY IN A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE
