Ramadan, in Islam, is the ninth month of the Muslim calendar and the holy month of fasting. It begins and ends with the appearance of the crescent moon. Ramadan begins 10–12 days earlier each year because the Muslim calendar year is shorter than the Gregorian calendar year.

During Ramadan, Muslims engage in fasting from pre-dawn to sunset, abstaining not only from food and drink but also from sexual relations with their spouses and preventing them from engaging in immoral behaviours such as gossiping, lying, arguing, backbiting, etc. This period is a time for introspection and spiritual advancement, aiming to develop moral excellence and enhance one's piety for God, known as "Taqwa". Fasting extends beyond mere physical abstinence to encompass avoidance of negative actions, promoting discipline and self-control. Although fasting is obligatory for all Muslims who have reached puberty, exceptions are made for

In Muslim households, the day during Ramadan typically begins with a predawn meal known as "suhur," which is a modest breakfast-like meal. After the sunset prayer, families get together to break their fast with a meal called "Iftar," often shared with friends and neighbours. This meal traditionally starts with dates. Additionally, many mosques organize daily Iftar gatherings for the less fortunate and travellers, fostering a sense of community and generosity during the holy month.

During Ramadan, Muslims commemorate the "Laylat al-Qadr" (Night of Power), celebrated on one of the last 10 nights of the month, when Allah revealed the Quran to Prophet Muhammad as guidance for humanity. Muslims aim to read and practice the entire Quran during Ramadan, And the entire Quran is recited during special nightly prayers known as "Taraweeh".

Ramadan fosters a strong sense of social connection among Muslims, who frequently invite each other to Iftar and gather for prayers at the mosque. This period is marked by heightened acts of charity, as fasting cultivates empathy for the less fortunate. Many mosques organize food drives or fundraisers for charity during Ramadan, embodying the spirit of generosity and compassion that defines the holy month.

At the end of Ramadan, Muslims commemorate "Eid ul-Fitr," known as the Festival of the Breaking of the Fast. The day begins with a special prayer and sermon, and Eid includes feasting, games, and donning of new attire, with special gifts for children. "Eid Mubarak," meaning blessed festival, is the customary greeting exchanged as friends and families come together to socialize, eat, and reconnect with acquaintances, marking the joyous occasion.

HATSHEPSUT:

THE FEMININE PHARAOH OF EGYPT

Hatshepsut, one of the ancient remarkable monarchs of Egypt, denied convention and shattered gender barriers as she ascended to the throne during the 15th century BCE. Known for her ambitious building projects, successful military campaigns, and bold assertion of power, Hatshepsut left an ineradicable mark on Egyptian history even with attempts to erase her legacy by succeeding pharaohs.

She was born into a strong 18th-century family. Her parents were Pharaoh Thutmose I and Queen Ahmose. She married her half-brother, Thutmose II, who succeeded to the throne after their father passed away, and so started her journey to become a monarch. Nevertheless, Hatshepsut became the regent for their little son, Thutmose III, after Thutmose II's brief rule.

Instead of focusing only on raising her kid, Hatshepsut seized the chance to exercise direct control. This was unheard of in Egyptian history, and she used her claim to be the direct descendant of the main deity of the Egyptian pantheon, Amun-Ra, to justify her rule.

During Hatshepsut's reign, trade, diplomacy, and large-scale building projects were prioritized. She sent explorers to the far-off country of Punt, which was abundant in exotic commodities like incense, ebony, and myrrh. These endeavors strengthened Egypt's economy and acquired important resources needed for official events and religious rites.

Renowned architect Hatshepsut made a significant contribution to the field of architecture. Her trusted architect, Senenmut, created the enormous project of the funeral temple at Deir el-Bahari, which she commissioned. The temple complex had sculptures, cascading colonnades, and a massive pyramid representing her heavenly connection and authority. But after she passed away, her stepson Thutmose III tried to obliterate her memory and consolidate his own authority, posing a threat to her legacy.

The passage of time concealed Hatshepsut's true accomplishments, leaving her a mystery figure for future generations. KUMAR SANGAKKARA - A LIVING LEGEND -

umar Sangakkara is a former Sri Lankan cricketer who is widely regarded as one of the greatest batsmen in the history of the sport. Born on October 27, 1977, in Matale, Sri Lanka, Sangakkara had a remarkable career spanning over 15 years. Sangakkara was raised in Kandy, Sri Lanka. He attended Trinity College, Kandy, where he excelled in both academics and cricket. He was renowned for his elegant batting style, impeccable technique, and leadership on the field. Sangakkara represented Sri Lanka in all three formats of the game: Test matches, One Day Internationals (ODIs), and Twenty20 Internationals (T20Is). Sangakkara made his international debut for Sri Lanka in 2000 and quickly established himself as a key player in the team. He was known for his elegant batting

style, solid technique, and ability to perform under pressure. Throughout his career, Sangakkara achieved numerous milestones, including being the first player to score four consecutive centuries in ODIs, scoring over 10,000 runs in both Test and ODI formats, and leading Sri Lanka to the final of the 2011 Cricket World Cup. He holds several records, including the highest partnership in Test cricket (624 runs with Mahela Jayawardene) and the most dismissals by a wicket-keeper in a single World Cup (54 dismissals). Sangakkara amassed over 28,000 international runs across formats, including 63 centuries and 153 fifties. He is one of only six players to score over 10,000 runs in both Test and ODI cricket. Sangakkara served as the captain of the Sri Lankan national team from 2009 to 2011. Under his leadership, Sri Lanka reached the final of the 2011 Cricket World Cup. Sangakkara retired

from international cricket in 2015 after his final Test match against India. He continued to play in domestic T20 leagues for a few years before retiring from all forms of cricket. He has been actively involved in philanthropic activities and has spoken out on various

social issues. Kumar Sangakkara's life is marked by his outstanding contributions to cricket, his leadership qualities, and his endeavors beyond the cricket field. He currently has a huge fan following and is loved and respected by fans for his good attitudes and playing sports skills.
