After the research, we selected ten mothers from ten different families who suffering from difficulties there. At its core, the program seeks to recognize. By focusing on maternity needs and providing them with essential items such as toiletries and sanitary products for babies and mothers and dry foods. Furthermore, the program aims to provide comfort to the new born babies by encouraging mothers and add dignity to their motherhood.

We launch the project on 15th October 2022 and conducted it with the support and participation of our Leo family members. We have had an unstoppable way, when we have an inseparable bond with Leo family. With such a great bond, huge dedication and with all of your immense support the Mathru project grabbed a massive success. And also we received a huge support from the Administrative village officer of Divisional Secretariat Agunukolapalassa, village officer and maternal & child health service officer of the Dambaralla village. We had a lot of love from families of the mothers. Finally, Mathru team was able to empower some mothers in our country who are suffering from poverty, to realize their biggest hope in life and contribute positively to their communities and society at large.




